New to SWAC

- Students will have the option to complete Cooperative Education credits.
- Students will be able to use Credit Recovery to accumulate additional credits.
- Student's OSR will remain in the home school and the student will stay on the home school Roster.

Who Can Apply to SWAC

- Any WECD SB student who has earned 22 credits and is under 20 years old.
- Students who are struggling to complete their last high school credits and who would benefit from a "change in environment".
- Students are not required to be out of school for any length of time.
- 5th Year students looking for a college experience.
