SECONDARY SUMMER SCHOOL PROGRAMS

CREDIT RECOVERY (35% to 49%)

Credit recovery offers students an opportunity to revisit those areas of a particular course in which they were not successful. You must have achieved a minimum of 35% in the selected course in the current school year to be eligible for this program. This program runs from July 6 to July 26.

COOPERATIVE EDUCATION

Students have two options to earn credits through cooperative education: one credit (from July 4 to July 31) and two credits (July 4 to August 29). Preference will be given to those students applying to the program for the following reasons: ① students in Grade 11 or 12 in credit deficit ② students in Grade 12 requiring credits to graduate ③ students registered in the Specialist High Skills Major (SHSM) program ④ students registered in the Summer Company youth entrepreneurship program ⑤ students registered in the Focus on Youth summer program. **STUDENTS MUST HAVE A WORK PLACEMENT PRIOR TO THE START OF THE PROGRAM.**

DUAL CREDITS

Dual credit programs are ministry-approved programs that allow students, while they are still in secondary school, to take college or apprenticeship courses that count towards both the Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD) and a postsecondary certificate, diploma, or degree, or an apprenticeship certification. Approval from your School Success Team is required in order to apply.

FULL CREDITS

Full credit offerings allow **current high school students** to register in classes they may not be able to schedule during the regular school year, or to otherwise improve upon grades they have already earned. This program runs from July 4 to July 31.

INTERNATIONAL SUMMER ACADEMY

The International Summer Academy offers students the opportunity to improve their English skills, while also enjoying recreational and cultural activities. Students have the potential to improve their proficiency in the English language by one ESL level per month. Students will develop verbal, reading, comprehension, and writing skills, at the same time becoming more familiar with the “language of high school.” Students will participate in learning experiences designed to improve their self-confidence and ease the transition into the Canadian cultural environment. Students will develop leadership and team-building skills through their participation in their choice of a variety of sporting activities, including table tennis, baseball, soccer, hockey, volleyball, and gymnastics.

Students also have the opportunity to earn a credit towards their high school diploma and gain valuable experience in Canada’s work force through Cooperative Education

ELEMENTARY SUMMER SCHOOL PROGRAMS



GRADE 6/7/8 ESL/ELD PROGRAM

This course has been specifically designed to help Grade 6, 7, and 8 English Language Learners (ELLs) increase their verbal communication, reading, and writing skills in the English language. Students will use computer programs, as well as the Internet, to complete a variety of assignments that will assist in preparing them to meet the challenges of their next grade. Students who have been identified by their regular classroom teacher and ELL teacher as requiring additional instruction in English should consider this course.

GRADE 9 REACH AHEAD HOSPITALITY PROGRAM

This course has been designed for current Grade 8 students wishing to explore the hospitality and tourism industry. This course focuses on the areas of food handling, food preparation, the origins of foods, event planning, and local tourism. Students will develop an awareness of related environmental and societal issues, and will begin to explore secondary and postsecondary pathways leading to careers in the field.
